- I. Financial report Amber
 - a. Treasurer's Report Current balance of bank assets \$38,037.06 The fall fundraiser is not included in this total. That money will be deposited soon.

 - b. Rice & Warehime Update Amy We heard back from the Warehime Foundation that they will give us \$10,611.54 toward the goals, nets, and shed purchases. The Rice Foundation will reach out to us after their next meeting. We will receive a letter from them to find out what they're willing to give to us.
 - c. Partnership Marriott Order Goals? The goals have been questioned by some of our refs, so they are a priority. Cory is pricing them out. Steve K., Ryan M., Shawn, and Cory are working together to make sure we're getting what we need.
 - d. Email Response Please make sure you respond within 24-48 hours to let them know you've received their message and are working on it.
 - e. Playground Equipment Insurance is \$100 extra per year. We need to find someone to set the playground equipment up and where.
 - f. AED Grant Submitted \$350 with grant (Peyton Walker Foundation) submitted. We need to have a working AED at the fields.
 - g. Need VOLUNTEERS FOR DILLSBURG 2 parking attendants each day, \$15 an hour, Saturday 8:00 am-1:00 pm and Sunday 8:00-11:00 am Site Coordinator & Field Marshals (7v7 fields) Someone with truck to pick up equipment on Friday, 10/3 (8:30-9:00 pm). Parking attendants are filled. Amber can be site coordinator on Sunday and Jodi can help in pieces. Any help is welcomed, so we can host again in the future!
 - h. Small Games of Chance License We do have a license in case we want to fundraise going this route.
 - Buy Veo? A lot of teams are using Rich's Veo camera (\$25 per game). If we get one, we need to figure out how to split it evenly between the travel teams (cost and use).
